

## Vision

- Aims to facilitate consensus-building and interoperability of services across disciplines to achieve a shared knowledge representation
- Provide a harmonized and centralized single point of access to (NFDI) terminology services
- cross-domain service for the provision, curation, development, harmonization and mapping of terminologies

## What does TS4NFDI want to solve?

1. simplified integration: direct integration of terminologies to web services through widgets



2. **simplified access:** provides a single API for multiple terminology services

I am a biomedical researcher. Working with research data is frustrating when every source uses different terms, and I'm never sure which one are related to each other.
